UKC Entry Information

1. No substitutions of entries will be permitted.
2. Temporary Listings will not be available at the trial.
3. Entries must be on an official UKC entry form. Downloaded copies or photocopies of this form may be used as well.
4. Entries must include fees. Any entries without fees will not be accepted.
5. Entries must be complete and received by the closing date and time.
6. Written confirmation of entries will be made only by email as soon as practicable after receipt of pre-entries. If you do not receive your confirmation by the pre-entry closing date, contact the Event Secretary.
7. Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information in the entry forms.
8. Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries may be transferred from the entered class to another class for which the dog is now eligible, provided that a request is made on the appropriate form to the Event Secretary during the scheduled time for accepting entries.
9. All other corrections to entries must be made on the appropriate form to the Event Secretary during the scheduled time for accepting entries.
10. No refund of entry fees will be made for entries cancelled after the pre-entry deadline, except in the cases of bitches that come into season. Refunds may be obtained by providing the Event Secretary with a veterinarian's certificate verifying that the bitch came into season after the closing date. The certificate must be submitted to the Event Secretary before the date of the trial.
11. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
12. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization it is impossible to open or to complete a trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.
13. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.
14. If in the opinion of MABOC, the well being of dogs, exhibitors or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow, storms, hurricanes, lightning, or extreme heat, MABOC may cancel or stop a trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

You Probably Already Know This, But..

1. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of a UKC licensed event.
2. It is expressly understood that exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
3. Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds.
4. UKC will vigorously support any motel that files a complaint about exhibitors who fail to keep their dogs quiet or to clean up after them. In order that the bad conduct of a few exhibitors does not spoil it for the majority of responsible exhibitors, UKC will take strong disciplinary action against any offenders.
5. Dogs may not be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates. No dog may be left in an unlatched or unzipped crate.
6. Except when being judged or when crated, dogs must be kept on leash.
7. Building will be open to exhibitors Saturday at 7:30 am. Overnight security is not provided and no dogs may be left in the building overnight.
8. Exhibitors are responsible for being available for judging at the scheduled time. Exhibitors are expected to pick up their armbands as early as possible and to notify stewards in all rings affected by any conflict so that judges may more easily work around any conflicts.

HOW TO USE THIS ENTRY FORM:

- Licensed Conformation classes consist of:**
 - Regular Classes. Classes for intact dogs:** Puppy (6 mos., under 1 yr.); Junior (1 yr., under 2 yrs.); Intermediate (Senior) (2yrs., under 3 yrs.); Adult (3 yrs. and up); Breeder/Handler (6 mos. and up, handled by breeder or member of breeder's family); Champion; and Grand Champion.
 - Altered Classes. Classes for altered dogs.** Altered Puppy (6 mos., under 1 yr.); Altered Junior (1 yr., under 2 yrs.); Altered Intermediate (Senior) (2yrs., under 3 yrs.); Altered Adult (3 yrs. and up); Altered Breeder/Handler (6 mos. and up, handled by breeder or member of breeder's family); Altered Champion; and Altered Grand Champion.
 - Junior Showmanship Classes. Consist of:** Pee Wee (over 2 yrs., under 4 yrs.); Sub-Junior (4 yrs., under 8 yrs.); Novice Junior, Open Junior (8 yrs., under 13 yrs.); Novice Senior, Open Senior (13 yrs., under 18 yrs.)
- All entries must be submitted on the current "Official UKC® Entry Form". You may use one entry form to enter the same dog in more than one activity on the same weekend.
- Use a separate entry form for each dog entered in a club's event.
- Mail all completed entry forms to the Event Secretary listed under the event, unless otherwise specified. Make checks payable to host club.
- Obedience Trials, Agility Trials, Rally Obedience Trials, and Weight Pull events are open to all UKC recognized breeds and mixed-breed dogs with a valid Limited Privilege number. The Coursing Aptitude Test is open to all UKC registered and Mixed bred dogs with a valid Limited Privilege number.
- We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events. Important things to remember:**
 - Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at www.ukcdogs.com or call the Dog Events Department at (269) 343-9020. (TL fees are non-refundable, non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.)
 - All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Limited Privilege number.**
 - All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.
 - To be eligible to enter into the Breeder/Handler class, you must be one of the breeders of record, or a member of the immediate family of one of the breeders of record. Immediate family includes: spouse, parent, step-parent, child, step-child, brother or sister, so long as the handler is not a professional handler as defined by UKC Rules and Regulations.

WAIVER

All events are held under the Official Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs or firearms will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of a UKC Licensed event. UKC, its agents and employees, and the host club assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors and handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. UKC and the host club are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft.

By signing this form, I hereby agree to waive any claim, action, or lawsuit and further agree to indemnify and hold UKC, the host club and any approved UKC Judge harmless from any claims, actions or lawsuits resulting from my participation in this event, and any action, decision or judgment made by any UKC or host club representative or approved Judge under the official UKC Rules and Regulations governing this event. I acknowledge that the current Official UKC Rules and Regulations (Agility, Conformation, Junior Showmanship, Lure Coursing, Obedience, Rally Obedience, Terrier Race, Weight Pull) have been made available to me, and that I am familiar with their contents.
